HIGHLAND ORCHARDS HAS ACRES OF OPEN SPACE, THE BEST STRAWBERRIES, AND PLENTY OF FRESH AIR TO GO AROUND. WE HAVE TAKEN EXTRA MEASURES TO MAKE SURE THAT WE ARE ABLE TO PROVIDE YOU WITH FRESH, HEALTHY FOOD IN A SAFE ENVIRONMENT. WE'VE ELIMINATED THE USE OF OUR SHUTTLE, ADDED HANDWASHING STATIONS IN THE FIELDS, AND REDUCED THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE PERMITTED IN THE FIELD AT ONE TIME. WE ANTICIPATE CHANGES AND APPRECIATE YOUR PATIENCE AND PATRONAGE DURING THIS TIME.

- As an essential retail business, we will follow all government mandates and health department guidelines.
- Masks are required for all visitors (children under 2 excluded) on the farm at all times. Social distancing will be enforced.
- Do not come to the farm if you are sick or have come into contact with someone that has symptoms of Covid-19.
- Your reservation is non-refundable. Reservations are transferable and we will do our best to accommodate any changes in reservations.
- Weather and field conditions change quickly. Check FB or call before coming to the farm so you aren't disappointed.
- Place your curbside order before your visit and we'll get it ready for you while you pick! Most pies are made on demand - order 3 hours in advance to guarantee your selection.



PICK YOUR OWN RULES FOR 2020



- We provide all picking containers. Extra containers are available for purchase in the field. Only credit card or mobile pay options will be available in our field.
- Only people that have paid for picking are allowed in our fields. Everyone over 2 years old is required to purchase a picking basket.
- Adults must monitor their children at all times.
- Shuttles will not be used. Upon arrival, drive to the Red Shed and stay in your car. We'll check you in from there and give you directions to drive to the fields.
- 6 ft social distancing will be enforced at all times. Please be respectful of other pickers, our staff, and crops.
- Face masks are required for all pickers. Gloves are recommended.
- Follow all instructions from staff regarding the best picking locations and directions around the property.
- Porta-Potty and hand wash station are at the parking area at the fields.
- Do not eat any fruit in the fields. We recommend washing all fruit just before eating.
- If you touch a berry, please take it with you.
- No pets are allowed in the fields.
- Our playground is not cleaned regularly and is closed to the public at this time.
- Highland Orchards is a working farm with inherent risks. Be aware of holes, uneven ground, sticks, poison ivy, bees, and working farm equipment.

PYO FAQs

What is PYO?

The best part of Highland Orchards is "Pick Your Own" produce. Be a farmer for the afternoon and pick your own berries, apples, corn, peaches, cherries or other produce options.

I forgot to order an item. Can I add it to my order?

For your safety, we don't hold your credit card info. If you forgot to order something, place another order and let us know in the comments. We'll put the orders together and get them prepared for your arrival.

It's raining and I'm not sure if the orchard is open.

Even if you have a reservation, we encourage you to call before your visit so you aren't disappointed.

I reserved a time for picking but there's another pick-up time on my receipt. When should I be at the orchard?

Your reservation time is the time you put in the shopping card. The other pick-up time refers to your Curbside order. If you place an order for produce, donuts, etc, we'll have it ready for you after picking.

I don't see any available reservations or the time say "Out of Stock".

We will typically add reservations 1-3 days in advance. We add picking dates and times based on a variety of factors, including weather, crop availability, and access to fields.
